Mission and Purpose

Formed in 2010, the Institutional Research Committee (IRC) is to discuss and disseminate research data and information useful to campus constituents interested in or engaged in educational and scientific research. The committee's function is four-fold: 1) function as an Institutional Review Board, 2) function as a research review committee, 3) set the research agenda for the college, and 4) function as the meta-process evaluation arm of the college. The IRC meetings and committee-sponsored events serve as forums to promote a culture of inquiry and evidence at the college. The IRC serves as the body that ensures college compliance with federal regulations on research and the protection of human subjects, as per guidelines governing institutional review boards.
